

Annual data collection on students and graduates enrolled in Qualifications and Awards

Dear education providers,

As you are aware, the National Commission for Further and Higher Education (NCFHE) and the National Statistics Office (NSO) request your contribution to their data collection on education statistics carried out twice a year as follows:

- The students questionnaire (Annex 1 and 2) collected in March/April of each year covering students enrolled in that scholastic year for all types and statuses of programmes. e.g. In March 2020, the data to be collected is about students enrolled between October 2019 until September 2020.
- The graduates questionnaire (Annex 3) collected in December of each year covering students who would have completed their studies, in all types and statuses of programmes in that same scholastic year.
 - e.g. In December 2020, the data to be collected is about graduates who completed their programme between October 2019 until September 2020.

We are therefore sending this communication in advance to help you prepare the required data at a pace suitable for you. The data required is in Annex 1 and Annex 2 for students, and Annex 3 for graduates. This will ensure that all information collected is in conformity with NCFHE/NSO requirements when requested later in the academic year.

Moreover, to lessen your burden in having numerous requests from multiple entities, the NCFHE and the NSO shall collect data from different providers and then mutually share the data collected.

Kindly note that the MSA Act, Cap. 422 of the laws of Malta, the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and the Data Protection Act, Cap. 586 of the Laws of Malta, empower NSO as a statistical institute to request and gather confidential information for statistical purposes. The NSO shall be seeking your written consent to share data with the NCFHE. The data shared with NCFHE will anonymize students' details to protect their confidentiality. Therefore, NSO will remove the variables such as ID card number, names and surnames that render the information identifiable. You have the right to object to this data sharing, in which case, NCFHE will be duly informed and will in turn issue the request for information directly to your institution.

We would like to stress that this compilation and provision of yearly statistics to the NCFHE is a license obligation for all registered Further and Higher Education providers.





All NSO's employees and all NCFHE employees dealing with the data are officers of statistics and as such, have taken the oath of secrecy and are bound by confidentiality. Moreover, all data gathered is used on a need to know basis and no information which can identify a data subject, directly or indirectly, is published. Information is used for statistical purposes only. Data will be handled and collected in conformity with GDPR.

Credit mobility is defined as temporary tertiary education or/and study-related traineeship abroad within the framework of enrolment in a tertiary education programme at a home institution for the purpose of gaining academic credit.

The credit mobile experience can be either a study period or work placement/ internship/ traineeship or a combination of both.
